Tele2 will pay EUR 13.7 million for the spectrum, with 20 percent of the amount charged in 2016 and the rest to be paid over 15 years of the license lifespan.

In Q4, 2015, the Lithuanian business was the 2nd largest EBITDA contributor to the Tele2 group, providing SEK 138 million (less exchange rate fluctuations), or 10 percent of the group's total EBITDA.
