Tele2 AB: Dutch 4G Network Vendor Selection Completed

Stockholm - Tele2 AB (Tele2), (NASDAQ OMX Stockholm Exchange: TEL2 A and TEL2 B) today announced the results of the network procurement for the 4G roll-out in the Netherlands. The selected vendors are Nokia Solutions and Networks (NSN) for Radio Access Network equipment, Huawei for core equipment and Mavenir Systems for IMS equipment.

Tele2 has already started building the network locations and purchase orders with NSN, Huawei and Mavenir Systems have been placed. The equipment designs are based on criteria exceeding Tele2's Swedish best in class 4G network, thus paving the way for a highly competitive network in the Netherlands.

Günther Vogelpeel, EVP and CEO Tele2 Netherlands, commented: "The completed procurement, in combination with the recently announced site sharing and MVNO agreements, puts Tele2 in the right position to continue to challenge the players on the Dutch market. With this setting, we will roll-out a very strong 4G network whilst being highly cost efficient."

Joachim Horn, EVP and Tele2 Group CTIO, commented: "The procurement process has been very thorough, and the selected vendors will provide us with leading edge technology within their respective field of expertise.
